Nova Coffee is one of Rwanda's foremost coffee growers, processors, and exporters of red Arabica Bourbon founded by Mrs Agnes Mukamushinja in 2013.



“Our coffee develops slowly with cherry maturing to a vibrant deep red from the beginning of April to the end of June. We work with a group of 383 women grouped into Dukorerekawa Bukure Cooperative,” says Agnes.

Nova Coffee washing station is in northern Province, Gicumbi District.

The coffees are fully washed 100% sun-dried and the quality is taken care of throughout all the washing stages. The quality improves steadily because Nova Coffee encourages the growers to handpick and deliver well ripen cherries at the washing station and get a fair price in return.



In addition, Nova coffee is UTZ certified and are in the process of gaining the Organic, Café Practice and Rainforest Alliance certifications.

Black tea, Hibiscus, lime and strawberries aromas, bright citric acidity, rich and elegant body with juicy flavour.
